ELIGIBILITY

An eligible candidate must:

- Be a regional association member in good standing.
- Have been employed for a minimum of five years (with one or more PPAI member firms) or retired from a regional association member company in good standing.
- Have contributed time and talents to a regional association and served at least one term on a regional association board.
- **Not** be an active member of the regional association staff.

NOMINATION AND SELECTION PROCEDURE

Nominations for the Regional Volunteer of the Year Award shall be submitted by PPAI's Board of Directors, committee members, Regional Association members and PPAI staff (president, vice presidents and department directors with input from remaining staff who have frequent contact with volunteers). The Association's manager of awards & recognition will screen all nominations to eliminate ineligible candidates.

The nominations will be forwarded to the RAC Advisory Group who will select the award recipients. The Advisory Group may select up to a maximum of two award recipients each year. It is possible there may be some years when there will be no award winner.

PPAI Regional Volunteer of the Year Award honorees will be recognized during the 2011 PPAI Expo.
